Weather

Cold, overcast and dry (minimal insect or wildlife observed)

Areas

- 1 - Village gates (West) to Oak trees opposite Bradgate House
- 2 - Oak trees opposite Bradgate House to far end of Parish Cottage hedge
- 3 - Land in front of Parish Cottage to drainage ditch from village pond
- 4 - Opposite Treetops (South side of road)
- 5 - Rectangle between Applecross and Rose Cottage
- 6 - Village sign triangle
- 7 - Village gates (East) to Dairy Farm drive
